What are cookies

Cookies are small pieces of text sent to your web browser by a website you visit. A cookie file is stored in your web browser and allows the Service or a third-party to recognize you and make your next visit easier and the Service more useful to you. Some cookies are necessary for you to be able to make full use of the website's functionality.

Cookies can be "persistent" or "session" cookies. Persistent cookies remain on your personal computer or mobile device when you go offline, while session cookies are deleted as soon as you close your web browser. Whether a cookie is persistent or a session cookie depends on the purpose of the cookie. For example, a cookie that is essential for the website to operate is a session cookie, while a cookie that is required to recognize you and your preferences when you return to the website are persistent cookies.

We also use web beacons, which are used to collect data for ad delivery analytics and for specific events such as registration or conversion. A web beacon, also known as a web bug, 1 by 1 GIF, invisible GIF, and tracking pixel, is a tiny image referenced by a line of HTML or a block of JavaScript code embedded into our website.

How Finga uses cookies

When you use and access the Service, we may place a number of cookie files in your web browser.

We use cookies for the following purposes:

- To enable certain functions of the Service
- To provide analytics
- To store your preferences

What types of cookies are used by Finga

We use cookies to make our sites and services easier to use and to be able to adapt our sites and services according to your interests and needs. Using cookies that keep track of what you previously showed an interest in enables us to show you relevant information that hopefully matches your personal

preferences. We use both session and persistent cookies on the Service and we use different types of cookies to run the Service, which we generally categorize as follows:

Necessary cookies

We may use cookies to remember information that changes the way the Service behaves or looks, such as your language preference on the Service. We may also use accounts-related cookies to authenticate users and prevent fraudulent use of user accounts.

Personalization cookies

We may use these cookies to remember information that changes the way the Service behaves or looks, such as the "remember me" functionality, which is not strictly necessary in order for the Service to work. These cookies will expire after 1000 days.

Analytics and marketing cookies

We may use analytics cookies to track information on how the Service is used so that we can make improvements. We may also use analytics cookies to test new advertisements, pages, features or new functionality of the Service to see how our users react to them.

Third-party cookies

In addition to our own cookies, we may also use various third-party cookies to report usage statistics of the Service, deliver advertisements on and through the Service, and so on. Below is a list of the third-party marketing and personalization cookies we currently use. Note that these cookies share data with third parties.
